3-step application process

1 Apply for support by submitting your study concept

To streamline the application process, gather the materials necessary to supply the following information:

- Key study contacts and site information
- Study concept and design
- Projected study timeline
- Amount of product/funds requested

When you are ready to apply, go to www.AnimasIIS.com, Applying for Support.

Apply for support using Visiontracker, a Web-based IIS management tool.

2 Supply a complete protocol and budget

If your study concept is approved, you will be notified via e-mail and asked to submit a complete protocol and budget, an informed consent template (if applicable), and other study details.

3 Review and sign the clinical research agreement

If the protocol and budget of your project are approved, Animas will send you two copies of the draft clinical research agreement (typically within 4 to 6 weeks) for review and approval. When the terms have been accepted by all parties and the documents signed, you will begin to receive funding and/or product support from Animas. (It is not uncommon for the contract review and approval process to last from 4 to 6 months.)
